Shoel Silver lives in Toronto, Canada. He currently serves as Vice Chair of the Jewish Agency for Israel's Committee for the Unity of the Jewish People, chaired by Natan Sharansky, and is a member of its Executive and Board of Governors. At the end of September, 2011, he completed a four-year term as Chair of the Budget & Finance Committee of the Jewish Agency. Past Jewish Agency involvements include serving as Co-Chair of the Budget & Finance Subcommittee on Allocations. Shoel also co-chaired the Partnerships Subcommittee, which oversees the Partnership 2000 (now called Partnership 2gether) program that twins Diaspora and Israeli communities.

Shoel is the Chief Executive Officer of The Metrontario Group, a 65-year old real estate development and investment company begun by his late parents, with interests in Canada, the United States, and Israel. He graduated in political science and law from the University of Toronto, and is a member of the Ontario and California Bars. Shoel is a member of Beth Tzedec Congregation, a large Conservative synagogue in Toronto. He is married to Eileen and has three children.
