- * Food Stamps cannot be used to buy diapers
- * Diapers can cost \$150 a month per baby
- * 1 in 3 families struggles to buy diapers
- * Wearing a diaper too long can jeopardize a baby's health
- * Lack of diaper access can lead to tensions in the home which can lead to child abuse & neglect
- * Depends for adults can cost \$80-\$100 a month per adult

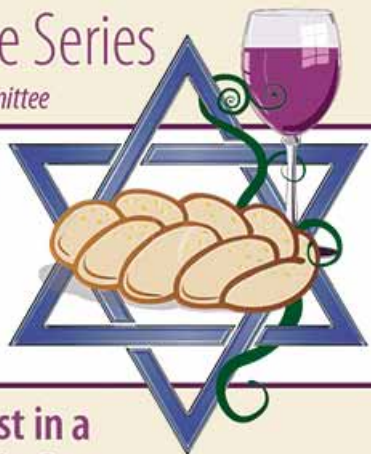
