What a blessing it will be to be together again for the High Holidays this year! We welcome you to join us in our beautiful Sanctuary or to stream our services on our Facebook page or the OST website. For the safety of everyone, masks will be required at in-person

services for those who are not fully vaccinated.

There are a few ways that our High Holiday observances will look a bit different this year than they have in years past. In response to our congregational High Holiday survey, our Worship Committee and leadership have made the decision to hold only one of each service this year. Overflow seating will be available in our Chapel in case of higher than expected attendance. We encourage you to arrive early to ensure that seating is available. A postcard will be sent to your address and will serve as your family's ticket. Friends and family are welcome to join us. Please call the office by September 10th to request a postcard for guests.

This move to only one of each service will allow both of us to be able to officiate our Children's Services, which will take place on the mornings of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur prior to our regular services. This is something we have both wanted to do for years, and we cannot wait to welcome our young families to sing and pray together. Childcare and activities will be available after these services so parents and older children can attend our regular services.

Due to spacing and ventilation issues in the choir loft, our volunteer choir will not be singing during services this year. Our professional octet will be singing instead, and we are so grateful to them for the mitzvah of their beautiful music. There will be an opportunity to hear our glorious full choir during a Yom Kippur afternoon Choir Concert, which will replace our Afternoon Service. Chuck Woodward and the choir are hard at work preparing a program of music which we know will be one of the highlights of this year's High Holidays. The concert will take place in the chapel and will be live-streamed for those who prefer to watch at home.


