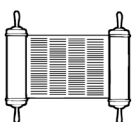

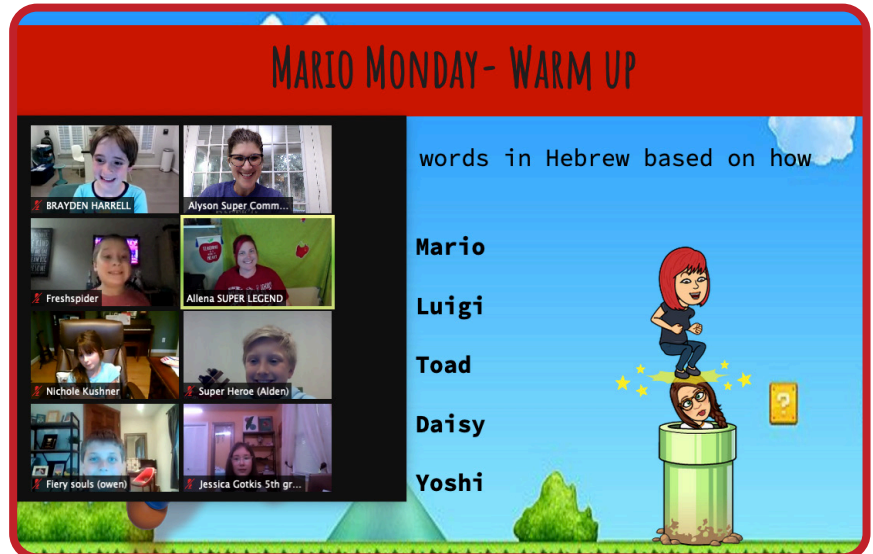

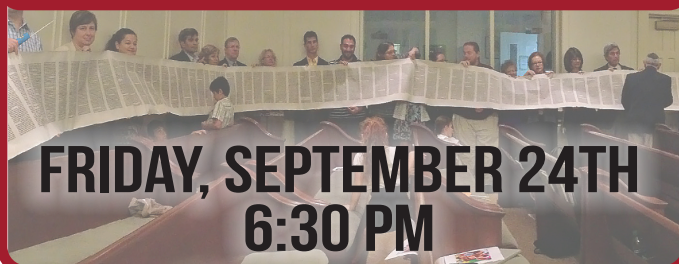

LIFE & LEGACY

Those memories in temple are some of my fondest of being Jewish.

Thank you for indulging me a short trip down memory lane from my childhood. On Rosh Hashanah eve we would convene as a family at Minnie and Louis Fine's home on Runnymede Road. This meant being picked up early at Norfolk Academy and changing into "temple clothes" in the back of the Vista Cruiser wagon. Those dinners were a mix of cousins, kid tables and lots of brisket.

Our family sat in about the same row every time in a long line of Fines. If I was lucky I got to sit next to grandmother Minnie. Those memories in temple are some of my fondest of being Jewish. I was never 100% comfortable or happy being in Temple as a child, but I understood the opportunity to all be together was special.

Later, when Karen and I had children, the row grew. I was thrilled that my kids got to sit as four generations together. Those powerful memories are a part of what led Karen and I to sit down with Kurt Rosenbach years after my grandparents had passed. His request that we consider a gift to the OST Foundation seemed like the perfect way to honor my grandparents. Karen had more motivation of providing for future generations but we both agreed we wanted to make a gift.

After exploring life insurance as our vehicle to give we were surprised how easy and effective a tool it could be.
