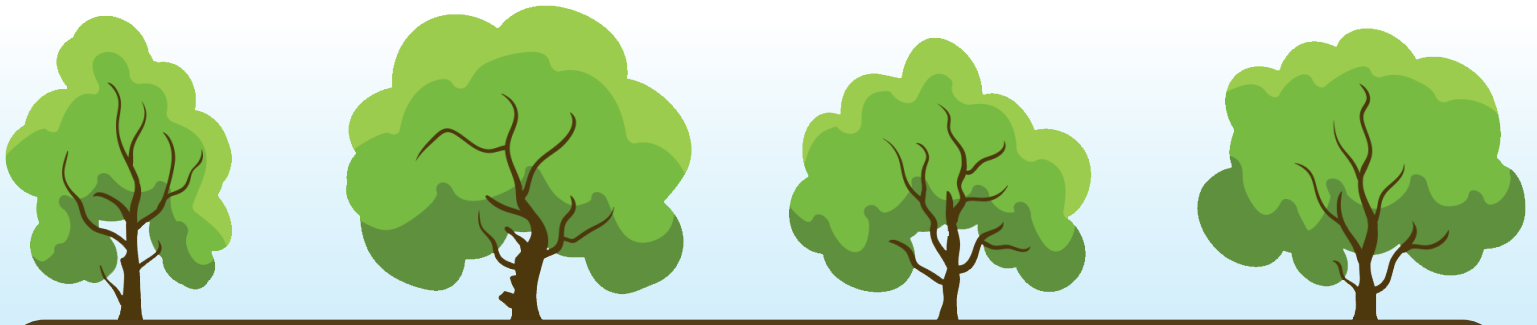
During these challenging times, having a Temple family is more important than ever.

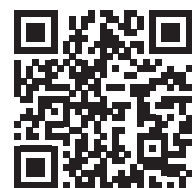

Remember, the newest candle is always lit first. The candles are added to your chanukiah from right to left, but are lit from left to right. When celebrating Shabbat and Chanukah, kindle the Shabbat candles after lighting your chanukiah.

LIFE & LEGACY has changed the trajectory of our entire Jewish community. Its impact will be felt for generations to come.

It is in large part because of the LIFE & LEGACY program, as well as previous and current fundraising efforts and the generosity of our congregation, that OST has been able to continue to provide the high level of Reform Jewish experience that it is known and valued for in our community. The OSF provides critical support to our operating budget, that without, our experience would be vastly different. Our endowment helps sustain us beyond general operations, allowing us to provide new programs and initiatives that would hitherto not be possible.

The High Holidays at Ohef Sholom



Here is a quick snapshot of how donor contributions and pledges have recently made a positive impact in our community over the High Holidays:

OST hosted 3 High Holiday study sessions which had a total combined attendance of 80 people and/or households.

160 congregants celebrated Sukkot at one or more of the 7 events OST hosted.

In total, Rosh Hashanah services reached nearly 5,000 members of our community AND Yom Kippur services reached over 5,400.

This is a small glimpse of how gifts made today or future gifts pledged through LIFE & LEGACY to our endowment impact our experiences TODAY. They give us the ability to adapt to the times, open and broaden our tent beyond our walls, and ultimately help provide a vibrant and relevant Reform Jewish experience for all those seeking one in our community and beyond. GRATITUDE SPOTLIGHT

Beverly and Jack Fox



With gratitude and appreciation, with each bulletin, we will recognize individuals who have contributed to the greater good of Ohel Sholom. This month, we recognize Beverly and Jack Fox.

After selling their business, Fox Quality Baking Company in Emporia, VA, Jack and Beverly relocated to Virginia Beach and joined Ohel Sholom. Since then, they have been continuously supportive of OST in a quiet and purposeful manner. Since Beverly was not Jewish when they first married (she has since converted) and his children all married non-Jewish spouses, they donated funds designated for interfaith programming. Similarly, motivated by their grandson's diagnosis of Muscular Dystrophy, a progressive muscle wasting disease causing him to be wheelchair bound, they saw the need for greater accessibility for people with disabilities. Their significant donation to the Special Needs Committee was used to purchase a wheelchair bimah lift, audio equipment for persons with hearing

limitations, the automatic door opener at the parking lot entrance, to contribute to the cost of the stand-alone accessible bathroom, and more.

When their daughter, Linda Fox-Jarvis, became chairperson of the Membership Committee and wanted to expand membership outreach, Jack and Beverly funded Membership activities and support. In a conversation with Cantor Jen and after attending their grandson's bar mitzvah rehearsal, they saw the need for wireless microphones and a new sound system and purchased them both. With the onset of the COVID pandemic making it imperative to be able to live stream our services, the Fox's generously funded each of these projects, increasing OST's engagement exponentially. Still to come are an additional camera in the chapel and hidden screens in the sanctuary for visual t'filah.

Beverly and Jack Fox are truly two of our unsung heroes at Ohel Sholom Temple, and we are deeply grateful for their generosity, vision, and leadership.
