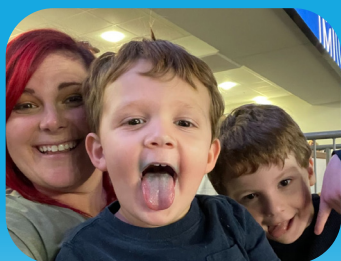
Alyson Morrissey

will be receiving my Bachelors in Human Services in December of 2022 from ODU. I am very excited to start as a teacher this year.

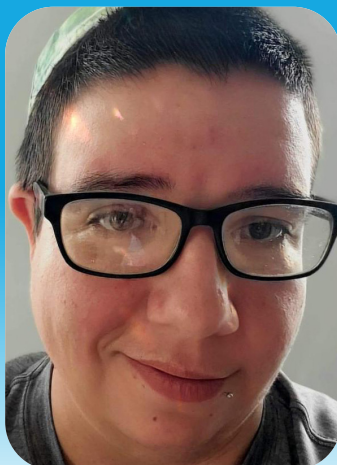


Robyn and Paul Weiner

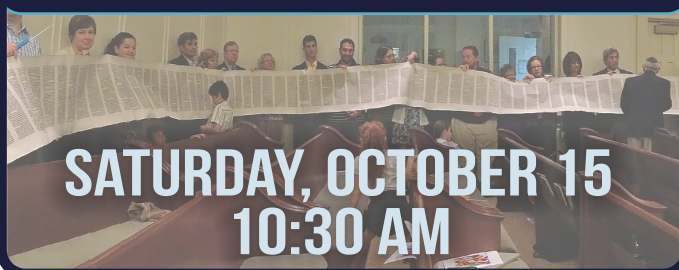

Eco-Judaism: Four Adama Questions

**Is your yard lacking vigorous growth?
Does it have bare spots?
Are the plants not doing much growing?
Are you frustrated?**

If you answered "Yes" to any of these, it may be time to test your adama, soil, instead of your patience.

Soil tests find what nutrients are lacking in plant growth and can help you improve your soil, save you time and money because you will not be buying needless soil additives, and help reduce amounts of unnecessary fertilizer that leaches into our water supply.

The process is simple. Put your soil sample in a box with the paperwork and a \$10 check to Treasurer, Virginia Tech. Details of the process on digging soil can be found on line at Joseph R. Hunnings, et al. (2019) "Soil Sampling for the Home Gardener." There are many other articles on Virginia Cooperative Extension's (VCE) website on different topics, not just gardening.

Because Eco-Judaism believes that caring for adama is a major part of good stewardship, we will:

- provide a Soil Test Kit, available at OST – also at libraries, VCE offices, and events sponsored by Master Gardeners and others groups.
- mail your soil sample, if returned to OST by October 2.
- provide information on the test on OST's Facebook page.

You may need to do multiple tests since different plants have different needs.

Completing a soil test is a great way to end this Shmita year. It is a way to give our gardens a healthy restart and demonstrate good stewardship of G-d's earth.

ENGAGEMENT COMMUNITY OUTREACH

OST hosts two meaningful programs in service to our community and to let our homeless and hungry neighbors know that we care about them.



October 18, 2022

The city has opened a new shelter at the previous Budget Lodge on Tidewater Drive, and they house 100 previously-homeless residents in shared hotel rooms. The Center is replacing NEST, so homeless guests will no longer have to move from place to place. Breakfast and dinner are provided to the residents, but they are dependent on meals being brought in.

Our OST Soup Kitchen and NEST committees and volunteers have joined forces to support The Center and help ensure its success. Our Mitzvah Meals volunteers prepare meals in our Temple kitchen, individually portion them, and then transport 100 clamshells, drinks etc. to The Center. We also distribute new Bombas socks, individually-packaged toiletry kits and laundry sheets. Our hot "home-cooked" meals and fellowship are greatly appreciated by the shelter leadership and residents. We need 10-12 people to prepare dinner for 100 people, portion it into clamshells and transport it all to The Center in a very limited timeframe.



October 31, cancelled September 26 for Rosh Hashanah

For 12 years, OST has opened our doors on the last Monday of every month to our hungry and homeless neighbors, some of whom sleep right outside our doors. Our Soup Kitchen has evolved into much more than just the feeding of hungry people. We offer a plentiful clothes closet, a dozen or more toiletry items, a brown bag meal-to-go in addition to our hot lunch meal, and friendship and fellowship for our guests. All of this takes many hands to be successful. If you have some time to give to these appreciative folks once a month, we welcome you to join us.
