DREIDEL, DREIDEL...

- Any number of people can take part.
- Each player begins the game with an equal number of game pieces (about 10-15) such as pennies, nuts, chocolate chips, raisins, matchsticks, etc.
- At the beginning of each round, every participant puts one game piece into the center "pot." In addition, every time the pot is empty or has only one game piece left, every player should put one in the pot.
- Every time it's your turn, spin the dreidel once. Depending on the side it lands on, you give or get game pieces from the pot. For those who don't read Hebrew, some dreidels also feature a transliteration of each letter. If yours doesn't, use the photo above as a cheat sheet:
 - → Nun means "nisht" or "nothing." The player does nothing.
 - A -Gimel means "gantz" or "everything." The player gets everything in the pot.
 - -Hey means "halb" or "half." The player gets half of the pot. (If there is an odd number of pieces in the pot, the player takes half of the total plus one).
 - Shin (outside of Israel) means "shtel" or "put in." Peh (in Israel) also means "put in." The player adds a game piece to the pot.
- If you find that you have no game pieces left, you are either "out" or may ask a fellow player for a "loan."
- When one person has won everything, that round of the game is over!



ECO COMPOST

Why is everyone talking about it?

"Turn it and turn it, for everything is in it"

These words by Ben Bag-Bag (first century c.e.) as cited in Pirkei Avot 5:26 - refer to the study of Torah but can also be applied to the composting process. Compost is composed of layers of decaying organic material. The turning of these layers results in a nutritious organic soil amendment that brings added nutrients to the plants and vegetables that are enriched with this mix.

Whether you are a seasoned or beginning gardener, everyone seems to be talking about compost. Compost is made up of three materials: the green layer (nitrogen and proteins), which is composed of grass clippings, coffee grounds, teas bags, vegetable and fruit scraps and eggshells, the brown layer (carbon) is composed of fall leaves, uncoated paper, cardboard, coffee filters and straw or hay, the third material is water.

The ingredients are layered and microorganisms break down the materials. Within a few days the pile heats up to about 160 degrees, the temperature that kills many weed seeds and harmful organisms. The pile is "turned" to give all the material a time to be in the center of the pile where the temperature is the highest. The final step is curing, when the temperature levels off. This assures that the most active stage of decomposition is complete. The finished product is dark and crumbly with a pleasant, hearty smell and is ready use as a soil amendment.

The gardens at our Temple use commercially available compost as a soil amendment. Listed below are some articles that provide more information. If you are interested in composting at home please feel free to contact Marc for more information.


